The Wellesley Board of Public Works held a duly posted open meeting in Room 301 of the Wellesley Middle School, 40 Kingsbury Street, convening at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT

Those present included Chairman David A.T. Donohue, Commissioners Paul L. Criswell and Owen H. Dugan; Director Michael P. Pakstis; Assistant Director David A. Cohen; and Town Engineer David J. Hickey.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Upon motion duly made by Mr. Criswell and seconded by Mr. Dugan, it was unanimously,

VOTED: To approve the Open Session minutes of the meeting of March 8, 2016, as presented.

CITIZEN SPEAK

The Chairman provided those in attendance with the opportunity to speak regarding matters pertaining to the Department of Public Works. No one chose to speak.

ADMINISTRATION

2016 Annual Town Meeting. The Director and Board reviewed DPW-related business in preparation for the first evening of Annual Town Meeting.

CONTRACTS

Statement of Fact: Washington Street Reconstruction – Phase 2 – Contract #16C-410-1557. Following a review of the recommendation by the Director and upon motion duly made by Mr. Dugan and seconded by Mr. Criswell, it was unanimously,

VOTED: That the award for Contract No. 16C-410-1557, "Washington Street Reconstruction Between Forest Street and Morton Street (No. 402 to 486 Washington Street)" be made to U.S. Pavement Services, Inc., 39 Industrial Parkway, Woburn, MA 01801, all in accordance with our specifications and their bid in the amount of \$582,479.52, as the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

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Statement of Fact: Hunnewell Field Restroom Replacement Project – Contract #16C-410-1558. Following the Director’s review of the recommendation not to award and upon motion duly made by Mr. Dugan and seconded by Mr. Criswell, it was unanimously,

VOTED: That no award be made at this time for the “Hunnewell Field Maintenance /Restroom Facility Replacement Project,” Contract #16C-410-1558 as the bids received on March 10, 2016 have exceeded the Town’s available funding.

Statement of Fact: Wellesley High School Track & Field Renovation Project – Contract #16C-410-1560. Upon motion duly made by Mr. Dugan and seconded by Mr. Criswell, it was unanimously,

VOTED: That the award for Contract No. 16C-410-1560, “Wellesley High School Track and Field Renovation” be made to Heimlich Landscaping and Construction Corporation, 65 Burlington Street, Woburn, MA 01801, all in accordance with out specifications and their total bid in the amount of \$2,912,000, subject to Town Meeting approval, as the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

Statement of Fact: Hot Mix Asphalt, Picked Up – Contract #16S-420-1562. Upon review of the bid recommendation and upon motion duly made by Mr. Dugan and seconded by Mr. Criswell, it was unanimously,

VOTED: That Contract #16S-420-1562 for Hot Mixed Asphalt, Picked-Up be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, T.L. Edwards, 100 Wales Avenue, Rear, Avon, MA 02322, in accordance with our specifications and their bid prices as follows:

Item I: Class I Type I-1 Top, Binder, Dense (Curb) & Surface Treatment Mixes (March 15 – December 14)	\$58.45/ton
Item II: Class I type I – 1 Top Mix ONLY (December 15 - March 14)	\$88.00/ton

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Next Meeting. It was decided it would not be necessary to hold a BPW meeting on Tuesday, March 29, at 6:30 p.m., as originally scheduled to be held prior to Annual Town Meeting.
