The Town of Dover has prepared a draft Hazard Mitigation Plan to reduce the Town's vulnerability to natural hazards such as flooding, droughts, hurricanes, and blizzards, and to increase resilience to climate change. Dover's previous plan was prepared in 2016 and is due for an update. By completing this plan, the Town will be eligible for grants from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for mitigation projects.
