NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS TO CONSIDER PRESERVATION DETERMINATION FOR A BUILDING AND TO CONSIDER REDUCTION OF DELAY PERIOD IMPOSED ON DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS

**Public Hearings to be held by the Historical Commission at a meeting to begin at
7:00 p.m. on Monday, March 9, 2020 in the Great Hall in Wellesley Town Hall.**

In accordance with Article 46C, Historic Preservation Demolition Review, of the Town of Wellesley Town Bylaws, the Wellesley Historical Commission will hold a public hearing to consider whether or not a building used as a dwelling at 15 Mayo Road, constructed on or prior to December 31, 1949 and intended to be demolished, should be Preferably Preserved.

Furthermore, the Wellesley Historical Commission will hold public hearings to consider a reduction of the Delay Period imposed by the Commission on the demolition of the building used as a dwelling at the following locations:

- 31 Elm Street
- 25 Rice Street
