In accordance with Article 46C, Historic Preservation Demolition Review, of the Town of Wellesley Town Bylaws, the Wellesley Historical Commission will hold public hearings to consider whether or not a building used as a dwelling, constructed on or prior to December 31, 1949 and intended to be demolished, should be Preferably Preserved at the following locations:

- 140 Weston Road
- 367 Worcester Street
- 3 Bobolink Road

Furthermore, the Wellesley Historical Commission will hold a public hearing to consider a reduction of the Delay Period imposed by the Commission on the demolition of the building used as a dwelling at the following locations:

- 60 Windsor Road
