Minutes from the meeting of January 13 were approved.

Construction Update:

- Staff walked the Park with the contractor April 27. Emphasis is on wrap up of the project. The contract has been extended to June 30 with the goal of the contractor being done and out of the Park by Labor Day.
- There continues to be discussion regarding the quality of the path surface. Much of the loose aggregate was swept up in October. There was discussion of a request on behalf of residents at Phillips Park to pave a section of path to make it more accessible to residents with walkers. The current path surface meets ADA requirements.
- The biggest issue currently is grass establishment throughout the Park. The goal is for the contractor to turn the Park over to the Park Dept. with reasonable maintenance.
- Establishing the invasives management services contract is in process.
- The work to complete the granite benches acknowledging CPA funding of the FBRP is scheduled for May 8.
- Hiring for the new FB maintenance position (Horticultural Technician) is in process.
- The Trails Committee has scheduled a walk in FBP Saturday May 20.
- The next meeting of the FBPC is May 30, 2017, 8:00a.m. DPW Board Room.
