

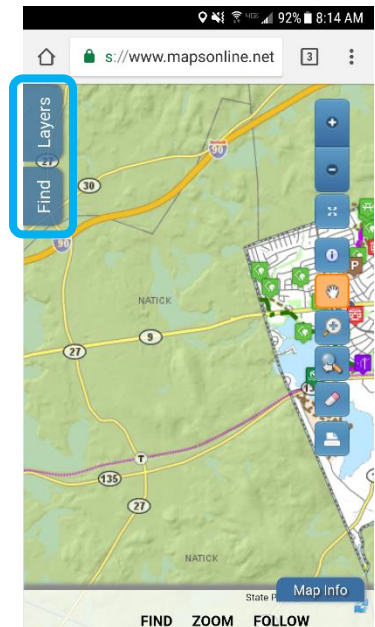


## Using the Wellesley Trails Online Map

The Wellesley GIS Department and Trails Committee have created a website to help you navigate Wellesley's trails both on your computer and on your phone.

To use the site, just follow the instructions below:

1. Open your web browser and navigate to <https://www.mapsonline.net/wellesley/trails.html>
2. In the top left corner of the screen you will see your 2 map tabs: **Layers** and **Find**.
  - a. Tap or click these buttons once to open the menu and then again to close the menu.
  - b. On the **Layers** tab, you can turn on and off certain map layers such as Points of Interest or Open Space
  - c. On the **Find** tab, you can use **Quick Zooms** to find a point of interest or **Find Properties** using the address.



3. For phones, at the bottom of the screen you will see your 3 navigation tools: **Find**, **Zoom**, and **Follow**. Make sure your phone's GPS is enabled to use these tools.
  - a. Tapping the **Find** tool will pan the map to center your current location on the screen. You will also see a blue dot that represents your location.
  - b. Tapping the **Zoom** tool will zoom the map in to your current location.
  - c. Tapping the **Follow** tool will make the map track your location as you walk along the trails.

Using this map relies on your phone's GPS location; it may not always accurately identify where you are. If you discover a problem on the trail (downed trees, erosion, etc.), please take a screenshot of your location and email it to [trails@wellesley.ma.gov](mailto:trails@wellesley.ma.gov). Make sure to describe the issue!
