A Message from the RDF to residents who use the facility.

The staff at the RDF is working hard to maintain services while adhering to the emerging COVID-19 guidelines. The most challenging and congested times are typically the last hour of each day and all day on Saturdays. In an effort to keep everyone well, we ask that all residents who use the facility adhere to the following guidelines:

- Use the facility during non-peak hours when possible, specifically Monday through Friday from 7am to 10am
- Maintain social distancing (minimum of 6 feet) at all times and especially along the recycling wall
- Only place CLEAN recyclables in the recyclables areas. Used tissues, paper towels, wipes and similar items must go in the trash
- For questions, call the office at 781-235-7600 x 3345. Do not approach or engage the staff with questions. **When in doubt, throw it out!**
- Please do not socialize while at the facility. Make your trip as brief as possible to make room for other users coming behind you.
- The RDF is now limited to DROP OFF ONLY. The Reusables, bookshelf, and compost areas are closed until further notice. Please do not stop, park, or congregate in these areas.
- All community activities at the RDF such as campaigning, fundraising, collecting signatures, etc. are suspended until further notice.
- The office is closed for walk in service. Call 781-235-7600 x3345 with questions or for assistance.
