COVID-19 Safety Standards Checklist for Public and Semi-Public Swimming Pools

If swimming lessons/programs are available, must follow the youth sports standards	
Facility operating at a 50% capacity	
Locker rooms, changing areas and showers open to only 50% capacity	
Close or mark lockers to enforce 6 feet social distancing	
Social distancing methods are put in place (ex. spacing out & limiting deck seating) and signage posted around the pool deck.	
Individual (not lifeguard) is made responsible for disinfecting high-touch surfaces and shared objects each time they are used as well as occupancy and other safety standards	
System for cleaning and separating cleaned and disinfected equipment	
Disinfectant is EPA approved for coronavirus and labeled	
Hand sanitizer available	
Covid Signage posted at each public entrance (see guidance for language)	
Staff attestation completed at the beginning of each shift – anyone experiencing symptoms are excluded from work	
Visitor log maintained and available with contact information	
Pool testing and pool shocking done more frequently	

Note: All pool operators shall immediately inform the Wellesley Health Department of any known positive case(s).
