GENERAL INFORMATION

Register for members of your immediate family only.

AGE POLICY

Children must be the proper age on the FIRST DAY of class.

PAYMENT

Non Residents add \$10 per course. Payments can be made by cash, VISA, MasterCard or by check payable to Town of Wellesley,

NOTE: There will be a \$25 additional fee for checks returned by the bank.

COURSE CANCELLATION

Classes that do not attain the minimum enrollment will be cancelled 48 hours prior to the scheduled start date. Full tuition will be refunded. We reserve the right to reschedule or change classes. You will be called if your class is cancelled, otherwise, plan on attending.

COURSE CONFIRMATION

If you provide your email address you will receive an email confirmation/receipt. If a class has reached its maximum enrollment, you can place your name on the waiting list by using the online registration system. If a class does not meet the minimum participant requirements, it will be cancelled and you will be notified. Otherwise, please plan on attending the course.

MAKE UP CLASSES

All attempts will be made to reschedule classes that have been cancelled due to inclement weather or instructor absence. We are not responsible for making up classes that are missed due to the participants' inability to attend.

SWITCHING/CHANGING CLASSES

Switching sessions, dates, or classes constitutes a withdrawal from a class and a cancellation fee applies.

REFUND POLICY

If a program meets more than 4 times, you will receive a refund minus a \$20 admin fee if you notify the Rec. Dept. prior to the second class. No refunds or credits anytime after the second class.

If a program meets 4 or fewer times, or meets for five consecutive days (ie. camps, vacation programs, skiing), you will receive a refund minus \$20 admin fee if you notify the Rec. Dept. five business days before the start of the class. (Please note, camp refund minus a \$25 admin fee for KinderCamp, Camps Joey, Q, Adventure and CIT Program.) No refunds/credits anytime after five business days before the start of the class.

COOKING CLASSES

No refunds for cooking classes if you withdraw 3 business days or less before the first class. Withdrawal from a cooking class 4 business days or more before the 1st class, there will be a \$20 administrative fee.

CLASS SPECIFIC REFUND POLICY

Please note that there may be a specific refund policy for a particular class. The specific policy information will be noted in the class description or in a text box near the class description.

We HIGHLY recommend that you sign in to the online system a few days before registration to make sure that your account is working properly.

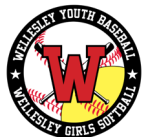

The Wellesley Town Band is BACK! After an extended, forced, lay-off, we are thrilled to be able to resume what we enjoy most, making music together! If you have ever played a brass, woodwind, or percussion instrument, there's a chair, music stand, music, and a warm welcome waiting for you in the Wellesley Town Band! Players of all ages (Grade 8 upwards) are welcome, no auditions are required. The Band has a real family feel, with spouses, siblings, and parents and students, all playing together.

In our ninth playing season, the Band is once again be led by legendary Wellesley schools band director Henry Platt. Rehearsals are held in the High School band room on Mondays 7-8:30 pm from September through mid-June (excluding school holidays). There is always a friendly, supportive, and enjoyable atmosphere of making music together. The repertoire is traditional concert band fare: light classics, favorite show tunes, and stirring marches. Each year the Band presents its popular Winter Concert in December and a Spring Concert in June. It has also performed outdoors for Mass-Hort's Gardeners' Fair at Elm Bank in May, and the Wellesley Summertime Concert series at Town Hall in June.

Annual fee is \$175 for thirty-three 90-minute rehearsals (Sept. 12 – June 12) and three concert performances. Mid-year registrations are welcome, with a pro-rated fee. 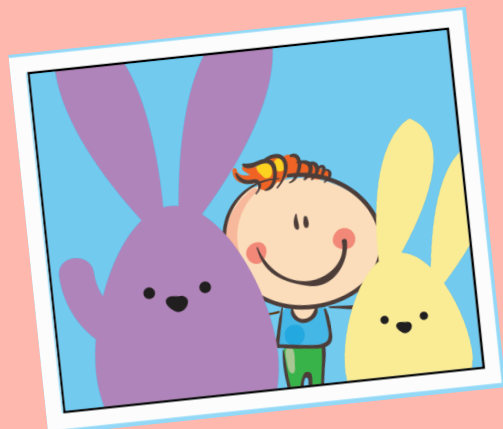

WELLESLEY TRAILS SPRING 2023

Guided Walks



Come along to enjoy some of Wellesley's beautiful open spaces and discover trails that will expand your recreational options! The walks are free, and no registration is required. Most walks cover 1.5 to 2 miles and last about one hour. Participants are encouraged to wear sturdy footwear.

GUERNSEY PATH & WABAN ARCHES • SUNDAY, APRIL 30 • 10 - 11:00am

Walk along the Charles River to the historic Waban Arches built in 1876 to carry water to Boston and see the picturesque view of the Charles River from the top of the 50-foot arches. Take an optional short walk through the Guernsey Sanctuary to Sabrina Lake, the 1870's site of an amusement park. Meet at the Guernsey parking area. Directions: Take Dover Road from Washington Street and follow for 0.7 mile. Turn right onto Livingston Road, which becomes Winding River Road, and follow for 0.9 mile. Small parking area is on your left at the trail map house. For other cars, please park on the opposite side of Winding River Road from the parking area.

BROOK PATH • SUNDAY, MAY 14 • 2 - 3PM

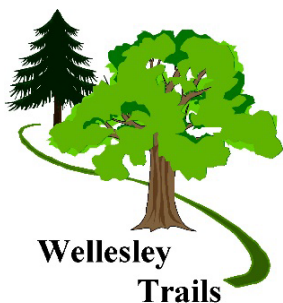
Take a pleasant Mother's Day walk along Fuller Brook Park and through an historic part of Wellesley. The walk follows a flat stone dust path that runs roughly parallel to Washington Street along the Fuller and Caroline Brooks. Established in 1899 and designed by John Charles Olmsted (nephew of Frederick Law Olmsted) and others, the park is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Meet at the Cameron Street parking lot at Washington and Cameron Streets.

MORSES POND TRAIL • SATURDAY, MAY 20 • 9 - 10am

Celebrate Wellesley's Wonderful Weekend with a morning walk. Explore the trails along Morses Pond, a 102 acre pond and a source for our town water wells. View the pond, islands and wildlife. The walk will take you through a pine forest along the Cochituate Aqueduct and along the shore line to the town beach. Meet at the gate to the town beach access road, located at the end of Turner Rd., 0.3 mi. west of Weston Road. Please park on the wooded side of Turner Rd.

HEMLOCK GORGE & ECHO BRIDGE, SATURDAY, JUNE 3 • 9 - 10:00am

For National Trails Day, explore the trails in Hemlock Gorge, a scenic and historic area along the Charles River at the corners of Wellesley, Needham and Newton. Get a birds-eye view of the gorge from Echo Bridge, a 70-foot high stone bridge across the Charles River built for the Sudbury Aqueduct in 1877. Stand under the main arch and count the number of times you hear your echo. Meet at the Echo Bridge Office Park parking lot at 381 Elliot Street, Newton. Directions: Take Rt-9 toward Newton, exit at the first ramp after the I-95 interchange (to Chestnut Street). At end of ramp, turn right onto Ellis Street and go under Echo Bridge. Turn right at Chestnut Street, and at the traffic light, turn right onto Elliot Street. The office park lot is on your right, and please park at the far edge of the lot by the brick building along the river.

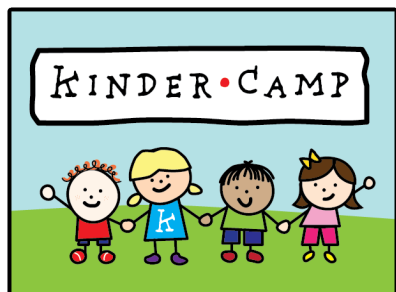

Camp Q is our traditional day camp for children entering grade 1 & 2. Please note that children entering grade 2 will now be at Camp Q. Daily activities include arts & crafts, sports, science and more. Camp Q offers an extended day program until 5pm. for an additional cost. Campers will go to Morses Pond on Mon/Wed/Fri and Field Trip Day is Tues & Thurs. Children are required to bring a snack, lunch and a water bottle unless otherwise notified.

WICKED FINE PRINT...BUT IMPORTANT!

FULL PAYMENT: Full payment for all sessions is due by July 1, 2023 (*except installment billing*). All registrations after July 1, 2023 are paid in full at time of registration.

INSTALLMENT BILLING (auto-debit payment plan): You must put down a \$50 deposit per week with registration. The remaining amount will be divided into 4 equal payments which will be auto-debited from your card on the 1st of each month until payment is complete.

STAFF: All Sr. Counselors are 18 or older and all Jr. Counselors are 14 or older and both attend an orientation session that includes First Aid & CPR training. Each counselor is CORI/SORI checked each year.

FIELD TRIPS: Field trips are typically within an hour to two drive from camp. If you do not want your child to attend a field trip, you must arrange to keep your child out of camp that day. Camp Q field trips are on Tuesdays and Thursdays, weather permitting. Campers will receive a camp T-shirt to wear on field trips. Field trip locations will be posted online once confirmed.

MORSES POND: Campers will be bused to Morses Pond to swim and play three days per week, weather permitting. All campers must pass a swim test performed by the Morses Pond staff in order to swim in the deep water area. Camp Q campers are required to wear PFD's (personal flotation devices) which are provided by the camp if they do not pass the swim test.

WHAT TO BRING: Each camper should bring two snacks (nut free), lunch and reusable water bottle daily. Refrigeration is provided except for field trips. Campers should bring a swim suit, towel, change of clothes, and sunscreen everyday.

CAMP FORMS: CampDocs is a safe and efficient way to collect all the forms required for summer camp. All Health forms, permission slips, authorization to administer medications, and immunization records, must be filed electronically at www.CampDocs.com. Shortly after registration with the Recreation Department, you will receive an email from CampDocs asking you to log in and access your account. If you have any trouble uploading or scanning any documents you may bring them to the Recreation Office for assistance.

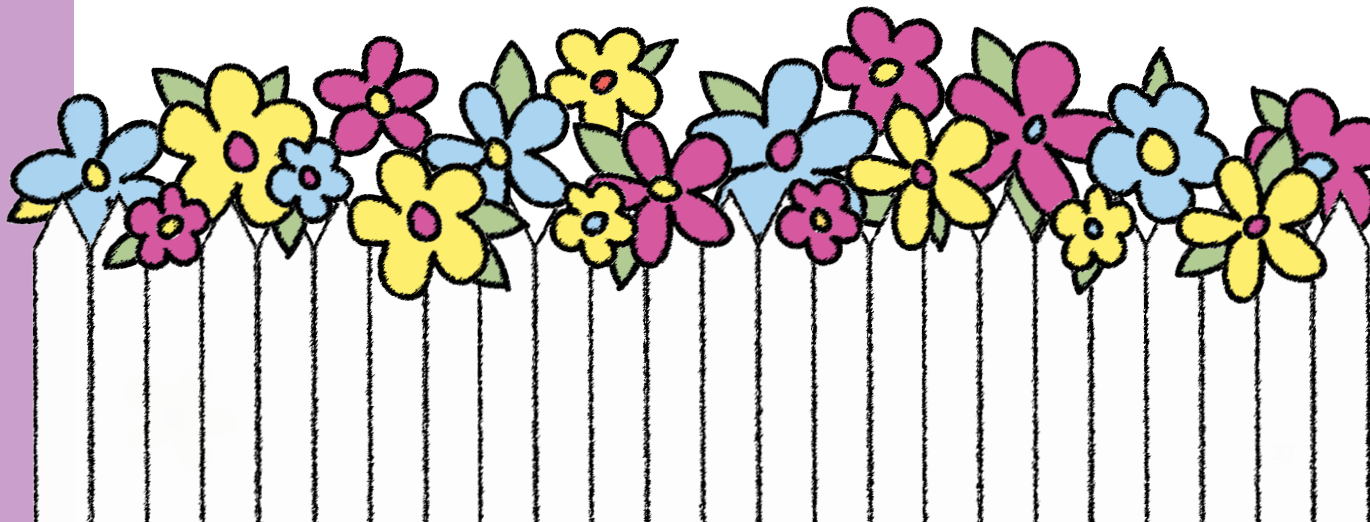
