



MBTA Proposed FY24-28 Capital Investment Plan (CIP) Public Comment Period

What is the CIP?

The **Capital Investment Plan** or CIP is the five-year financial plan that funds all the MBTA's capital projects. Capital projects are investments or activities related to acquiring, renewing, constructing, improving, or maintaining a capital asset, including project planning and design.

We update the five-year CIP annually to ensure we are investing in the safety, reliability, and modernization of the MBTA.

What does this mean for me?

We're renovating stations, modernizing technology systems, upgrading services for our buses, subways, and ferries, and improving the accessibility of the entire system. The CIP includes 600 unique capital projects to invest in the transit system and improve your experience on the T
